

## La visione "open": Sun

With Sun the megatender becomes an "open". Brainchild of architect Patrizia Sterpone (the renderings here are by architect Alessandro Silvestri), the Sun concept is indeed a big 24 metre open featuring soft and alluring lines developed on a structure of dynamic design. At the same time, in line with the megatender philosophy which highlights outdoor liveability, organisation of the spaces aiming at inter-changeability between exterior and interior which can be done in just a few seconds by transforming the structure from covered to uncovered. The whole spacious living area within the deckhouse becomes "open" simply by opening up the large transparent surfaces and the furniture along the sides, sliding back the big door aft and raising the glazed deckhouse dome forward to let sun and sky into the boat! Maintaining contact with the outside was an objective pursued also in design of the interiors, where natural light is admitted below deck through large cut glass panels, some of which can be opened as in the owner's cabin forward. Bright interiors are further exalted by the choice of modern, minimalist-inspired furnishing materials like glass and steel. As for the layout of the spaces it was decided to favour the shared areas and limit the number of cabins to three, two are doubles and one with two bunk beds, all with en suite bathroom. At the moment the more technical aspects connected with hull and propulsion etc. have yet to be studied in depth. But the vessel's sporty, high performance look makes it easy to predict a deep-V chined hull for "SUN", driven by powerful engines capable of high speeds.
